

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR MUTUAL COOPERATION
BETWEEN
THE KOREA DEMOCRACY FOUNDATION
AND
OCTOBER 14 FOR DEMOCRACY FOUNDATION**


The International Cooperation Center in Korea Democracy Foundation (KDF-ICC) and October 14 for Democracy Foundation agree to establish a relationship of general cooperation. The objective of this relationship is to define the areas and modes of cooperation between the KDF-ICC and October 14 for Democracy Foundation. Mutual cooperation between the two Parties may be developed to enhance democracy in the following ways:

- Mutually sharing the publications and experiences
- Carrying out the cooperative projects, workshops and conferences in specific areas of interest to both Parties.
- Exchanging human resources.
- Providing support for training programs
- Exchanging information, documents and publications produced by the two Parties


The two Parties shall freely suggest and discuss ideas that may be developed from the areas and modes of cooperation specified in the present Agreement and implement them by mutual consent.

Any alteration of this agreement will be communicated by the two Parties with a minimum anticipation of 30 days. Any conflict or disagreement in the interpretation of this Agreement will be resolved based on the English version.

This Memorandum of Understanding will enter into effect on the date of signature, and its validity will be automatically renewed for subsequent periods of 2 years. This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by either Party on six months notice in writing. This Memorandum of Understanding may be modified by mutually agreed letters of amendment. The present Memorandum of Understanding is signed in four original copies, two in English and two in Korean, on the 5th day of the month of September of 2008.
